Fly Your Flag!

Does your Den have a Flag? – No. Well show your spirit and make one.



It's okay if you don't sew – What you will need:

- 1 – Standard pillowcase
- 1 – Roll Fusible Tape (Stitch Witchery)
- Craft Paint (Acrylic)
- Iron
- A Den full of Imagination

Insert cardboard into case, paint as desired, allow to dry, remove cardboard, heat-set fusible tape inside the hem (approx. 3 in from opening), cut-out flag pole loops from the edge to the fusible tape. Fuse top loop so flag pole doesn't slip thru.
