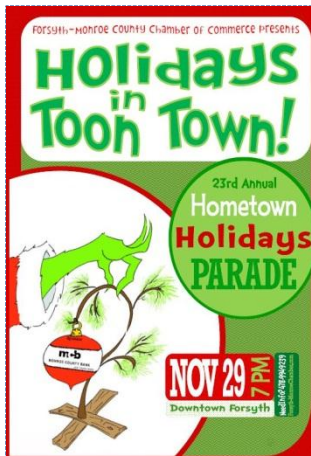

## Scouting History

In 1914, Baden-Powell began implementing a program for younger boys that was based on Rudyard Kipling's Jungle Book. A strong influence from Kipling's Jungle Book remains today. The terms "Law of the Pack", Akela, "Wolf Cub", "grand howl", "den" and "pack" all come from the book. At the same time, the Gold and Silver Arrow Points, Webelos emblem, and Arrow of Light emblem are taken from our American Indian heritage.
