## Foil Pack Chicken & Broccoli Dinner

Number of Servings: 4

1 package stuffing mix; chicken flavor  
1 ¼ C. water  
4 boneless skinless chicken breast; 6oz each  
4 Tbsp. ranch dressing

1 C. shredded cheddar cheese  
4 slices cooked bacon; crumbled  
4 C. thawed broccoli Florets

Oven to 400. Spray 4 large sheets of heavy-duty foil with oil. Combine stuffing mix and water. Spoon 1/4 of the stuffing mixture onto the center of each foil sheet. Top stuffing with a 6oz. chicken breast. Top chicken with 1 c. broccoli. Sprinkle with 1/4 of the cheese and crumbled bacon. Drizzle with 1 T. ranch dressing. Bring up foil sides and fold to seal, leaving room for heat circulation inside. Place packets on a cookie sheet or grill and bake 25-30 mins. Remove packets and let stand 5 mins.
