Banana Boat Campfire Recipe

Number of Servings: 4

Great at home or at the Fall Family Campout!

PREHEAT to 450°F or grill to medium-high.

CENTER one banana on each sheet of heavy duty aluminum foil. Top with brown sugar and margarine. Sprinkle with cinnamon. Top with chocolate morsels, marshmallows, nuts & coconut, if desired.

BRING up foil sides. Double fold top and ends to seal packet, leaving room for heat circulation inside. Repeat to make four packets.

BAKE 10 to 12 minutes on a cookie sheet in oven. **OR GRILL** 4 to 6 minutes. Serve with whipped topping or cherries if desired.
